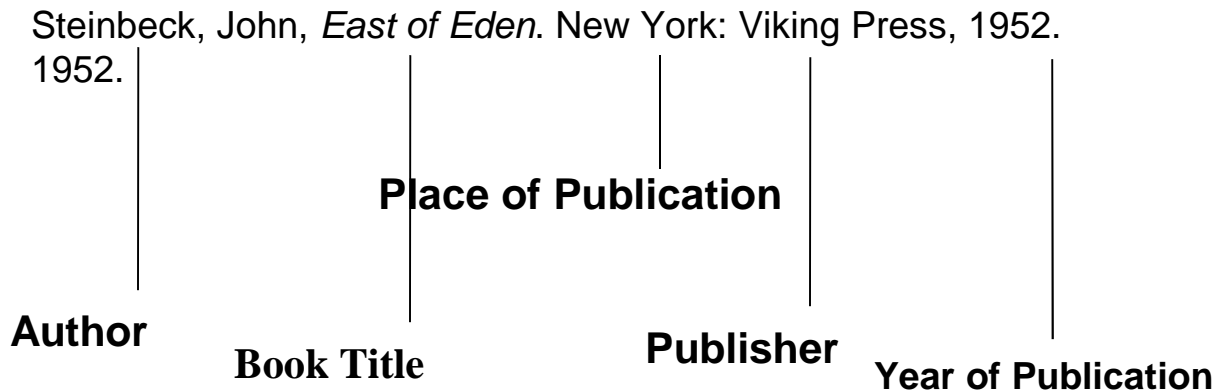


The Components of a Citation

Q: What information do I need to include in my citation?

A: Although styles vary, most bibliographic citations will include the author's name, the title of the work being cited, where and when that work was published, and who published it. The sample below labels the various parts of a basic bibliographic citation in Chicago—Humanities style.



However, citations can be more complex. Citing journal articles generally requires the researcher to include volume numbers, issue numbers, and page numbers in addition to the above information.
